

Preparing for prospective remedy



Legislative position

PSPJO Bill expected to receive Royal Assent shortly

Comes into force on 1 April 2022

Finance Act 2022 received Royal Assent on 24 February 2022

Comes into force on 6 April 2022

Home Office consultation response published 8 March 2022

Secondary legislation comes into force on 1 April 2022



Key provisions

Legacy schemes (FPS 1992 and FPS 2006) closed to future accrual

Protected members join FPS 2015

Existing transitional protections for legacy benefits remain in place:

- Normal Pension Age
- Final salary link
- Double accrual guarantee (FPS 1992)
- Actuarial commutation (FPS 1992)

Ill-health 'underpin' for cases that are in train


Existing Added Years and FPS 2006 special member contracts can continue



Key messages for 1 April 2022



All members MUST be in the FPS 2015 on 1 April 2022



This includes payroll and admin systems



Not to achieve this presents legal and reputational risk



Expectations of software suppliers

Solution in place to ensure all remaining members are transferred to FPS 2015 from 1 April 2022

Communicated and delivered to administrators in sufficient time

New CARE record created for all transitional members from 1 April 2022 to start from 'nil' balance



Expectations of administrators

Implement transfer of all remaining members to FPS 2015 from 1 April 2022

Cross-check with FRA?

Update websites and other resources to reflect:

- the closure of the legacy schemes, and
- end of protected member status

Liaise with FRA on member communications



Expectations of FRAs

Ensure all remaining members are transferred into FPS 2015 from 1 April 2022 on payroll

- New payroll line for all members for reporting?
- 2022-23 contribution factsheet

Send cohort-specific 1 April 2022 letter to all members*

Distribute 'Your questions answered' factsheet

Monitor <u>optant outs – new factsheet</u> available!

Update websites and other resources

Consider possible upcoming IQMP referrals



After 1 April...

Follow up letter to former protected members to confirm:

- New contribution rates
- Opportunity to transfer (non-club basis); 12 month deadline for non-occupational
- Death grant nomination (FPS 1992)
- Cohabiting partner nomination (FPS 1992: not essential, but nice to have)

Managing member expectations

PSPJO Bill WILL become law on 1 April 2022 Protected members WILL move into the FPS 2015 on 1 April 2022 Members WILL NOT be 'put back' into their final salary schemes on 1 April 2022 Retrospective remedy WILL NOT be implemented until 1 October 2023 ABS 2022 WILL NOT reflect remedy benefits
