Officers' 1979 pay settlement

1. Station Officer to Senior Divisional Officer (inclusive)

With effect from 7.11.79 annual salaries will be as follows:

Senior Divisional Officer

2. With effect from 7.11.79, overtime rates will be as follows:

(a) Non-residential Station Officers

	<u>Basic hourly rate</u>	<u>Casual overtime rate</u>
During 1st year in rank	£3.22	£4.83
During 2nd year in rank	£3.30	£4.95
After 2nd year in rank	£3.37	£5.06

(b) Non-residential Assistant Divisional Officers

	<u>Basic hourly rate</u>	<u>Casual overtime rate</u>
During 1st year in rank	£3.40	£5.10
During 2nd year in rank	£3.50	£5.25
After 2nd year in rank	£3.61	£5.42

Note

- (i) The above hourly rates are derived by dividing the annual rate by 52.167 and then by 42.
- (ii) Paragraph (b) above introduces provision to pay shift-duty assistant divisional officers on the same principles as other shift-duty personnel for public holiday working (paragraph B2 of Section III of the Scheme of Conditions of Service) and for overtime (paragraph 12 of Section VI of the Scheme of Conditions of Service). The arrangements for payment for attendance at large fires (Paragraph 13(2) of Section VI of the Scheme of Conditions of Service) remain unaltered.

3. Maximum rent allowances continue to be at one-sixth of the maximum rate of pay for the rank concerned, in accordance with paragraph 1 of OC/7/79 and paragraph 3 (1) (c) (i) of Section VI of the Scheme of Conditions of Service.
